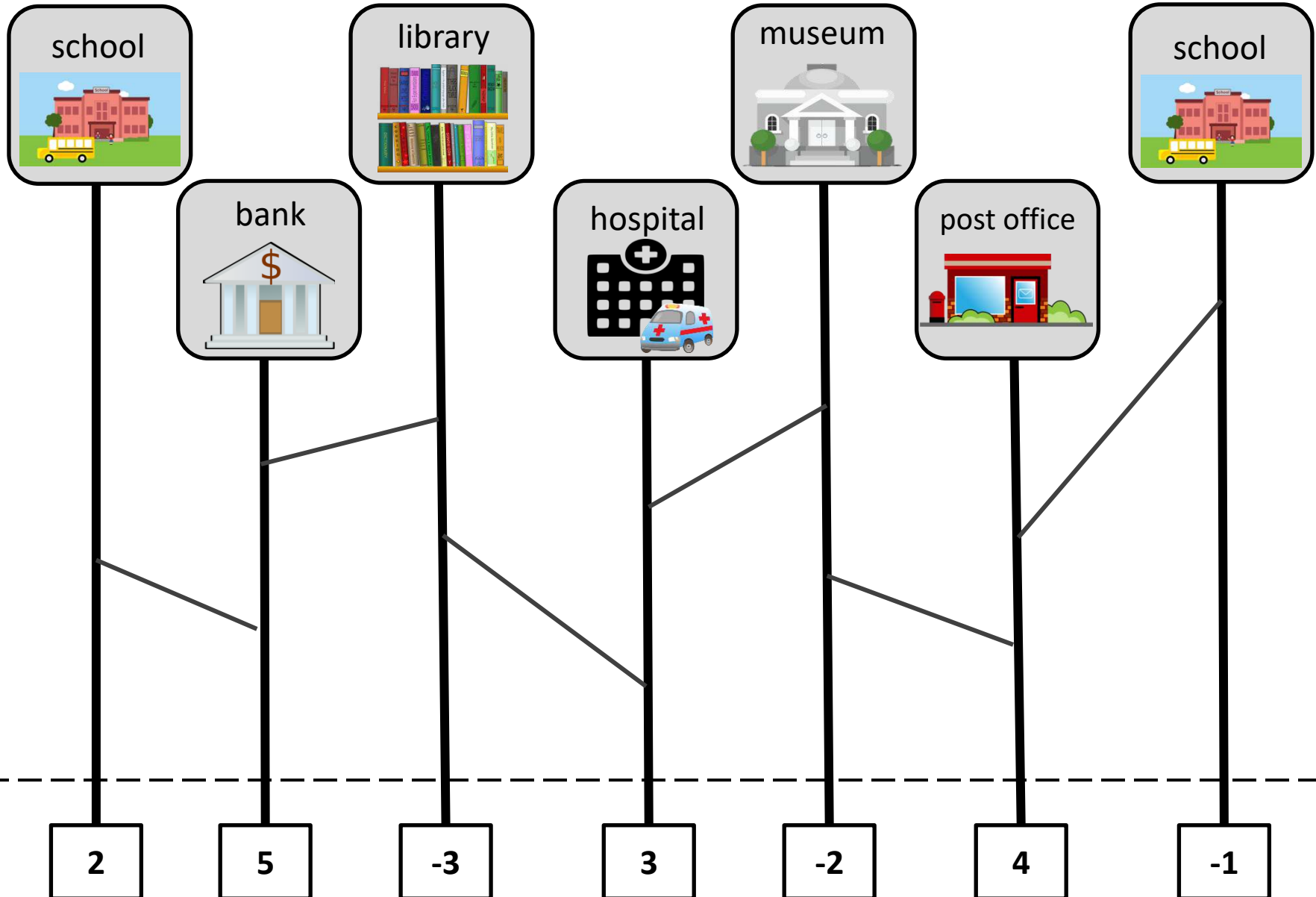

The Ladder Game : Buildings



HOW TO PLAY THE LADDER GAME:

This game is best played in **pairs**.

Give each pair of students one board game and ask them to fold along the dashed line so they cannot see the points. Then students can start the game.

- Students take turns choosing one of the pictures in the boxes.
- Then, with their partner, students should ask and answer using the target language. (e.g. 'How's the weather?' / 'It's sunny.')
- Then follow the ladder (line) down until you reach the points at the bottom.
- Then that student should draw **THREE** more horizontal lines anywhere.
 - Repeat many times, and remember to draw **THREE** lines every time.
 - The teacher can decide when to stop the game
 - The student with the most points is the winner.
