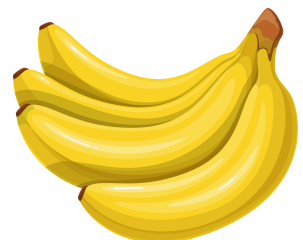
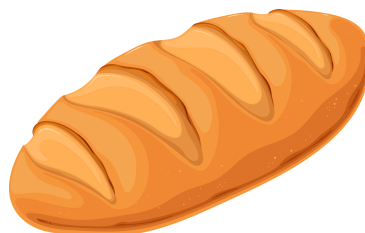




Countable and Uncountable Nouns
