1. If people eat too much food, they get fat.
2. If you heat water to 100 degrees, it boils.
3. If I wake up late, I am late for school.
4. If I study too much, I get tired.
5. If it is cold, I wear a jacket.
6. If I don't have much money, I don't eat out.
7. If I drink coffee, I can't sleep.
8. If I exercise, I sweat.
9. If I sleep early, I feel good the next day.
10. If you mix red and blue, you get purple.
